- * Underwear and other undergarments (new with tags)

They are also in urgent need of the following new, unused items:

- * Stockings
- * Socks
- * Make-up
- * Deodorant
- * Body wash and soap
- * Shampoo and Conditioner
- * Hair brushes, ties and clips
- * Make-up brushes and applicators
- * Donate a toilet bag with 5 or so unopened toiletries and cosmetics. E.g. deodorant, make-up, pantyhose (still in packaging).
