Palya means welcome and is the greeting of the traditional owners of Uluru and Kata Tjuta and surrounding lands. For tens of thousands of years the Anangu people have cared for this land and for that we are truly thankful. So Palya! Welcome!

Laura, Keshira and I have been planning the details of the journey for some time now and are pleased to be able to provide you with the following details.

The tour commences on Friday 19th July and ends on Monday morning 22nd July and includes the following:

- Accommodation at the Desert Sands Hotel- a 4.5 star hotel with free wi fi
- coach transfers to and from the airport
- return flights Melbourne to Uluru.
- a spiritual Shabbat experience led by Keshira Ha Lev which includes Kabbalat Shabbat, Shabbat services and Sounds of Silence dinner with Havdalah.
- guided garden walk
- mani mani indigenous cultural theatre
- bush food experience
- guided walk at the base of Uluru

Total cost per person is \$1950. The resort charges a single supplement which will be \$200 extra.

SHABBAT AT ULURU PROPOSED PROGRAM

FRIDAY 19th JULY

Arrival and settle into Desert Gardens hotel.

You will have time to explore your surroundings. The resort contains a town square with restaurants, supermarket, meeting places and several lookouts. There is also an Arts Museum and Camel Farm. A free shuttle bus circulates around the resort daily departing every 20 minutes.

KABBALAT SHABBAT AND DINNER followed by the first in our Jewish Dreamtime series – stories and singing with indigenous infusion.

SHABBAT 20th JULY

Breakfast followed by Shabbat services led by our spiritual guide Keshira HaLev with stories, singing and more indigenous infusion.

LUNCH followed by workshops including:

- Guided garden walk – a guide will explain the cultural significance of the key plants in the extensive gardens of the hotel grounds, showing how they are used as parts of food, medicine and more.
- Mani Mani indigenous cultural theatre – immerse yourselves in the dreamtime stories of the region with a performance of sensory beauty.
- Bush food experience – discover the uses of plants, fruits, grains and spices in traditional cooking methods.
- Learn bushman hunting skills in a chat with an indigenous guide about weaponry such as hunting spears, clubs and boomerangs.

SUNDAY 21st JULY

Breakfast followed by a guided walk at the base of Uluru along the Mala track. Hear stories of the history and traditions associated with Uluru.


LUNCH followed by free time to explore optional extra workshops or tours. Dot painting, 10 km base walk of Uluru, Field of Light tour or camel farm tour. These need to be booked through our travel guide Laura.

DINNER followed by storytelling, singing and sharing our experiences, activities and responses to this unique time we have spent together in this astonishing and spectacular place.
